

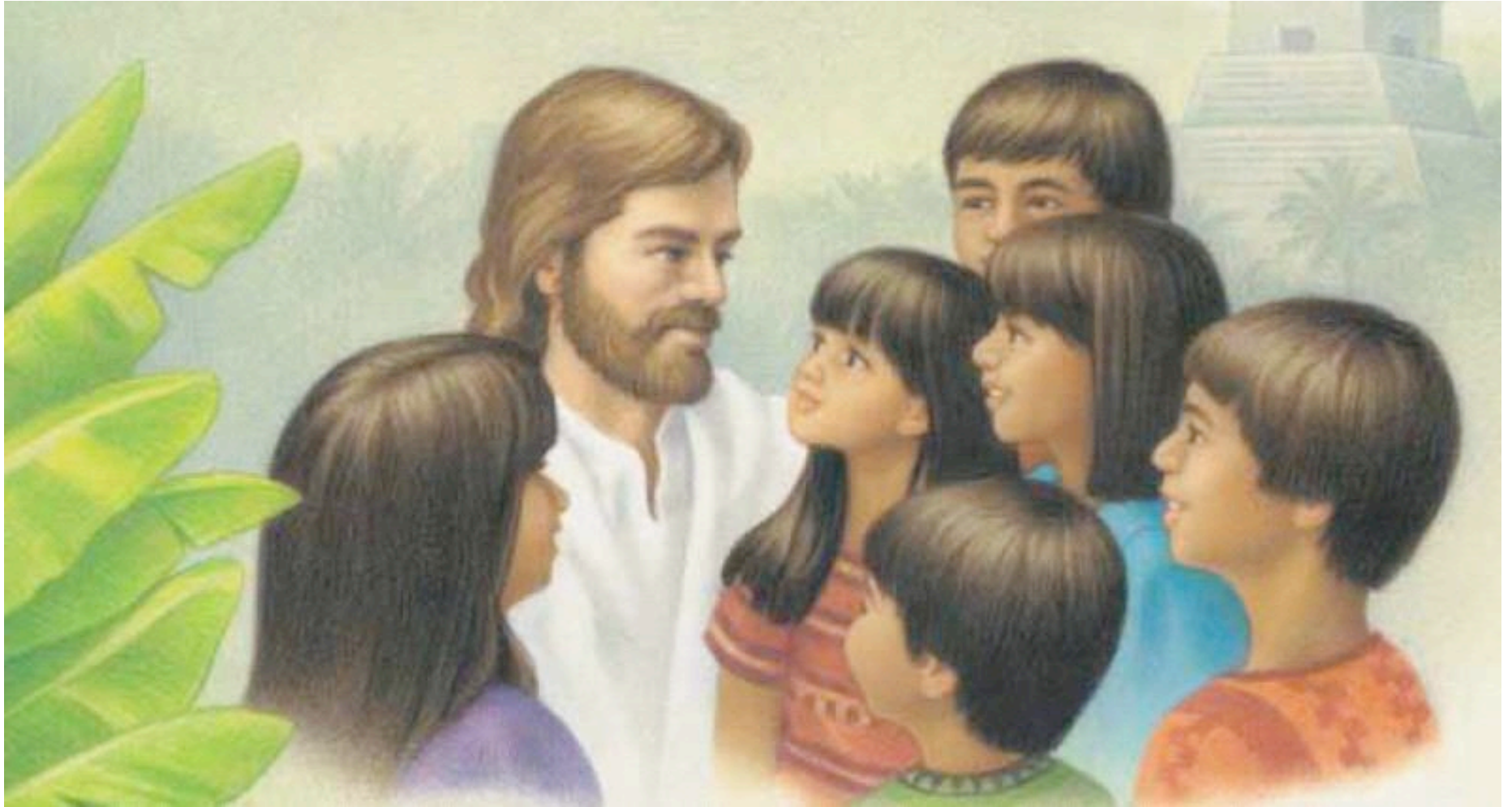

Had I been a child when Jesus came



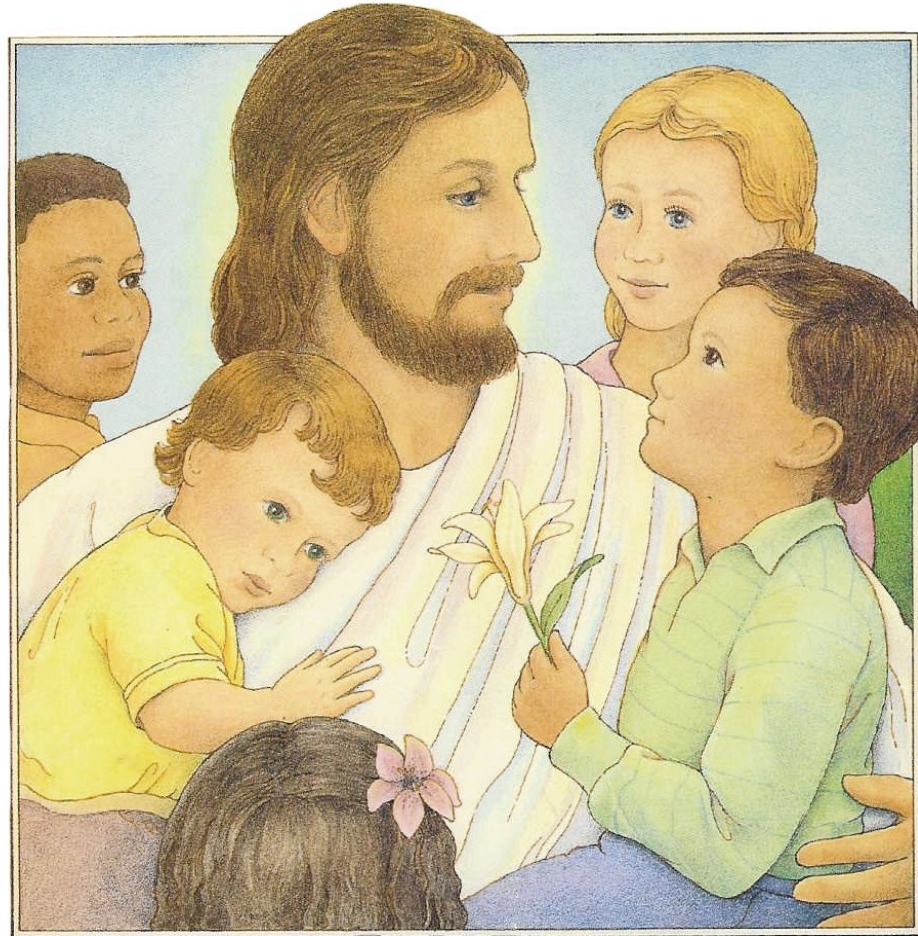
Unto the Nephites that blessed day
