the Savior said.



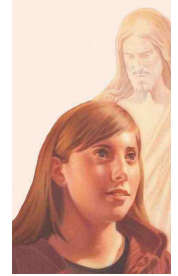
Then let us in

can we be one



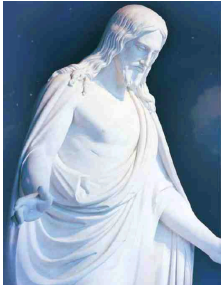
With God’s own loved,

words combined



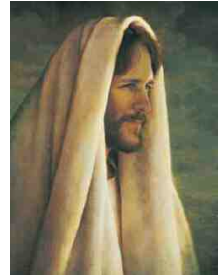
To urge, inspire

this vale of tears?



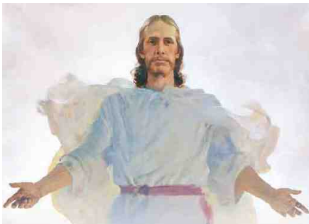
No, this extends
